




# COVID-19 Emergency Response

World Vision is responding to the impact of COVID-19 in **more than 70 countries.**

Our **US\$350 million response** aims to reach **72 million people,** including **36 million children,** especially the most vulnerable.

## World Vision's Key Concerns



We urge the world to stand together with the most vulnerable children to fight COVID-19, especially refugees and the internally displaced.



Devastating aftershocks of the crisis are putting at least 30 million children's lives at risk. We urgently need to address both the direct health impacts of the virus and the secondary impacts brought about by viral containment measures.



Children will need special support now – including psychosocial – to reduce anxiety and stress during and after this crisis.



Joining hands with faith and community leaders is critical to strengthen preparedness, to effect behaviour change and to protect children.




